### These priority groups will receive the 2009 H1N1 vaccine:

- ▶ Pregnant women.
- ▶ People 6 months through 24 years of age.
- ▶ People who live with or take care of infants younger than 6 months, including parents, siblings, and day care providers.
- ▶ People 25 years through 64 years of age with a chronic illness or weakened immune system.
- ▶ Health care and emergency medical services personnel.

### As more vaccine becomes available, these groups should also be vaccinated:

- ▶ Healthy people 25 through 64 years of age.
- ▶ Adults 65 years of age and older.

**Remember:** The H1N1 flu vaccine does not protect you against the seasonal flu and seasonal flu vaccine does not protect you against the H1N1 flu.
